



Fayetteville Free Library Community Display Space Policy

Overview

The Fayetteville Free Library (FFL) will provide a Community Display Space for the public to use in order to display information that meets the educational, professional, and recreational needs of our community. We will give preference to programs that focus on literacy. Other approved postings will include concerts, non-profits, cultural events, lectures, and workshops.

The FFL does not endorse the viewpoints or events posted in the Community Display Space.

Guidelines

Notices **must contain** the name, address or telephone number, and date of the event.

The library will **approve**:

- materials that can be viewed by a general audience
- materials that promote an educational or cultural experience for local residents

The library will **not approve**:

- materials that publicize or promote a particular church, religious organization or religious viewpoint
- materials that publicize or promote a particular political party, political organization or political viewpoint
- materials that publicize or promote a for-profit business

Procedures

All notices must be approved by a member of the Marketing Team, and will be dated and initialed before being hung. The Marketing Team will determine the initial posting date.

Notices will be removed when they are no longer timely, if they do not have approved initials, or when space is limited for more current items.
