



# 2022-2023 Proposed Budget

### 2021 Library Highlights:

- We reopened to the public! The library was open for 279 days. We averaged 174 daily visitors, for a total of 48,482 visits.
- Physical item checkouts went up 49%!
   We loaned out 551 books & media items daily.
- Digital item checkouts went up 25%!
   Patrons streamed or downloaded 183 books, movies, shows and music items daily.
- Attendance at our programs went up 37%! We hosted 592 storytimes, classes, & events with 7,929 attendees.
- Local families picked up 4,637 activity kits!
- ■498 new people signed up for library cards!
  Our total number of cardholders is 12,498.

For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, the library is requesting a 1.90% overall referendum increase.

#### How will the increase be used?

In light of significant inflation and increased costs of goods and services, a 1.9% increase is necessary in order to maintain our historic facility and meet community needs for library materials, programs and services.
