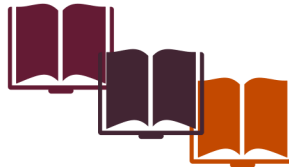

Understanding and Meeting Community Needs:

Hosted an Accessibility Resource Fair in partnership with Access CNY, ARISE, FM, FM HSA, and SU. Executed Library Accessibility survey and developed action plan. First step is staff training towards offering sensory friendly storytimes.



Partnered with Buy Nothing Fayetteville to host a community sharing event. 150 attended, many new to the library. Will repeat in the spring and likely monthly.

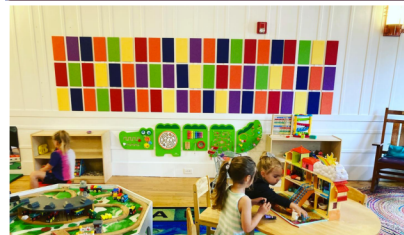

Reaching new users through outreach: we interacted with 220+ community members at FayFest!

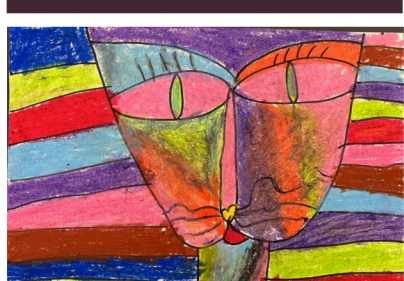
