Overview

The Fayetteville Free Library (FFL) provides a Community Display Space open to organizations engaged in educational, cultural, intellectual, or charitable activities to display information about their resources and/or events.

Posting of notices does not indicate Library endorsement of the ideas, issues or events promoted by those notices.

Guidelines

To be displayed on our Community Display Space, print materials must:

- Contain language and images appropriate for a general audience
- Be created by groups or organizations engaged in educational, cultural, intellectual, or charitable activities, displaying information about resources and/or events
- Fit on the Community Display Board or table
 - Posters must be no larger than 11x17

The library will not approve the following:

- Print materials created for the expression of the views or opinions of individuals or groups
- Print materials promoting commercial or for-profit products, services, businesses, or events
- Print materials containing hate speech or promoting the activities of hate groups

Procedures

All notices must be approved and hung by a member of the Marketing Team.

Notices will be removed when they are no longer timely, or when space is limited for more current items.

The Library assumes no responsibility for the preservation or protection of any materials delivered for posting. Materials will not be returned.
