

PROGRAM ATTENDEES



ITEM CHECKOUTS



DIGITAL CHECKOUTS



Total digital checkouts in 2025 was 85,767 - **up 7.39%** over the same period in 2024 and 21.91% from 2023


Technology Usage 2025

120 Average Daily Visitors


COMPUTER USAGE IN HOURS






